GMS Families,

Every year, we choose an organization or cause for our school-wide Christmas Project. This year we plan to partner with Hope Church of Milford to support the families of the Milford Boys and Girls Club during the holiday season. GMS parent, Mike Braber, is one of our recess volunteers and athletic coaches and is also a member of Hope Church. He will be our contact for this project. The overall goal of the project is to provide toys for every



child and take-home meals for the 80+ families who attend the club.
